This policy acknowledges that management methods alone do not give all of the answers to developing positive learning attitudes and high standards of behaviour. We have the best potential to succeed, if we support systems that have high learning expectations, empower individuals, and applaud their development. Similarly, while clear boundaries and consequences are vital, the emphasis in building a whole school policy should be on praise, recognition of constructive behaviour, the development of self-discipline, and students taking more responsibility for their own learning. This policy is the product of staff and student collaboration and conversation. This policy is based on current best practises and aims to address areas that need improvement. We must recognize work and performance on all levels to promote self-respect. Trust, listening, understanding, sharing and accepting responsibility, tolerance, encouragement, and positive interactions are all necessary components. Respect can be given, earned, kept and lost.

- Assisting all students, regardless of ability, age, or academic level, in the process of praise, recognition, and reward whenever feasible.
- Ensure that every student reaches their full potential.
- Establishing clear guidelines for students, staff, and parents.
- Developing a reputation for our students' integrity, honesty, strength, and brilliance on a local and national level.
- Creating a conducive environment for teaching and learning.
- Students, teachers, and parents will have a better grasp of the disciplinary process.
- Having a more consistent approach to praise, incentives, and positive learning attitudes.
- Best practises are being developed.

Attitude for Learning and Rewards

Celebrating positive attitudes and accomplishments are a critical component in developing respect and promoting positive attitudes and behaviour. At every opportunity, staff should endeavour to encourage, praise, and reward all students, regardless of ability, age, or gender. As a vital basis in all exceptional schools, this must be frequent and meaningful, both official and informal.

Aims We use our rewards system to:

- Create a secure, orderly and working environment.
- Raise student self-esteem and make them feel valued.
- Set goals for personal achievement.
- Reward a variety of qualities and activities.
- Provide opportunities for students to aspire to and assume responsibilities.
- Motivate and encourage students to do their best and achieve their potential.
- Ensure effective teaching and learning can take place.
- Develop the students' sense of appropriate and inappropriate social behaviour.



We will ensure that all students across the school will be able to benefit from the rewards process, and it will be consistently applied across the school.

CLASS DOJO REWARD SYSTEM

Students are rewarded points during the lessons or various other reasons dependant on the teachers. The points range from 1 point up to 5 points.

Students may also lose points for negative behaviours or attitudes.

Teachers are encouraged to track the students' points on class dojo, and reward them or the entire class for reaching a certain level of points. E.g. Having a class party to celebrate a students successful achievement in reaching 500 points within the term, or allowing students to have a civvies day etc.

Other rewards systems applied by the school:

Principal's Award

The Principal's Award is awarded to exceptional students who are nominated by staff for their outstanding contribution to the school community. This can be for academic achievement or for success beyond the classroom and behaviour. Students are also recognized for good attendance and behaviour in the school's Weekly News. They will also receive a certificate or badge.

Year Group Celebration Assemblies

Each weekly celebration assemblies will be held in all year groups to highlight significant levels of improvement and achievement by individual students. Students will also receive their rewards certificates earned for the week at this assembly. The emphasis in these events is on breadth and inclusion. Students will be recognized for their achievements in the week including attendance, sporting events, extracurricular activities, activities outside school and the number of achievements points they have gained on class dojo. In order to further develop a culture of praise and success, there will be an element of celebration of achievement as part of the year group assemblies each week. This will ensure students are clear about the value placed on the achievements of themselves and their peers.
